Jr. Fair Admission

Ross County Jr. Fair livestock shows are closed events this year. Only exhibitors and immediate family members are permitted to attend with appropriate wristbands for 2020. **All exhibitors and spectators ages 9 and up must wear wristbands when on the fairgrounds the entire time.** Participants in Round 1 ~ August 8-11, 2020 will be assigned a specific colored wristband (dogs, goats, horses, poultry and sheep). Participants in Round 2 ~ August 12-15, 2020 will be assigned a specific colored wristband (beef, swine, and rabbits). Participants who will be showing in both rounds or assisting with essential duties will be assigned a specific colored wristband for the week.
