

The Emergency meeting of the Ross County Agricultural Society Board of Directors was conducted on August 8, 2022, at the Ross County Fairgrounds, 344 Fairgrounds Road, Chillicothe, Ohio.

The meeting was called to order at 3:28pm by President Brad Cosenza.

Roll Call revealed that Cosenza, Clever, Gearhart, Free, Nelson, Haubeil Jr., Haubeil, Bethel, Boggs, Clifton, Hill, Elliott, Corcoran, Gray, and Pickerrell were present.

A discussion took place on an incident that happened at the Swine Barn and at Colburn’s campsite. On August 7<sup>th</sup> a professional trainer working in the swine practice arena was escorted off the grounds for not having a wristband after curfew. Mr. Colburn was outside of the barn and taunting parents and exhibitors that were working with their projects. Clifton was contacted by a Swine Barn Superintendent to come to the barn. E8-3-22: Boggs moved, Hill seconded to adjourn the meeting at 3:55 pm. Motion carried.
