

The special meeting of the Ross County Agricultural Society Board of Directors was conducted Monday May 22, 2020 at 5:00 pm electronically due to the COVID 19 Pandemic per the approval of Am. Sub. H.B. 197 by the Ohio Senate and House of Representatives.

This meeting was held with the Ross County Health Department. They conducted the meeting and we did not have the opportunity to take roll call. The meeting was not called to order by RCAS and there were no motions made.

Kelly Dennis conducted the meeting along with Chris Brown MD and Logan Calhoun.

They informed the SFB that the Covid-19 is 15 – 20 % community spread in Ross County. They spoke of the current Stay at Home Order being lifted with the strong recommendation from Governor DeWine to stay home if possible. They thanked the SFB for requesting the meeting to know what we are permitted to do at the fairgrounds. The Ross County Health Department has requested that plans be submitted for all aspects of the fair for approval. There is great concern of crowd control and the flow of the midway. Overall, they have serious concerns on how we can safely put on the 2020 Ross County Fair.

Feldhues inquired on only conducting a Jr. Fair. Dennis and Brown discussed with the SFB and Feldhues on how this could take place. A detailed plan will have to be submitted to the Health Department.

Bethel asked for approval of a face to face meeting the RCAS and with conditions, it was approved.

Motocross is approved with no spectators.

Non fair camping is approved with conditions.

Concerts at this time were not approved.

Building rentals are approved with social distancing.

Meeting adjourned at 6:18 pm.
